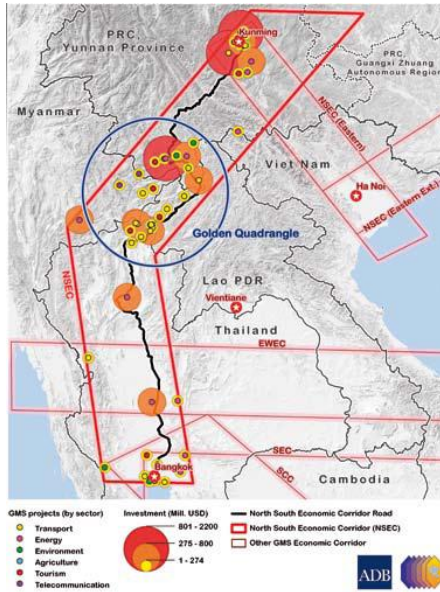
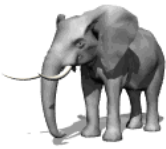

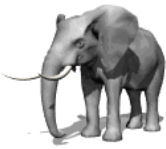
STRUCTURE AND AIM



Day one: Information sharing
