- **Partnership between CEP, ARBCP, ASEAN Center for Biodiversity and UNESCAP to pilot and develop regional approaches to Payment for Ecosystem Services**
- **Scaling up of PES pilot policy in Viet Nam and to Cambodia – select additional pilot sites and strengthen enabling policy conditions**
- **Capitalize and consolidate ecosystem values to secure on-going biodiversity conservation investments**
- **PES related to watersheds, carbon sequestration and/or aesthetic values to be mobilized to sustain infrastructure investments and create incentives for avoiding deforestation/habitat fragmentation**

Strengthening Engagement with the World Bank Institute



- **EOC to serve as regional incubator for WBI SEA training activities**
- **EOC to provide technical advise/review for proposed SEA of regional master plan (Red River Delta) in Viet Nam**
- **Assessing ADB's Country Partnership Strategies in Lao PDR to integrate environment/climate change**

- **Capacity building for planning and monitoring of power sector projects through ADB RETA 6440**
- **GMS Adapted Carbon Financing Guide to be developed for small scale renewable energy projects with support from Finnish Ministry of Foreign Affairs**
- **AFD interest in capacity development for energy efficiency/decentralized energy systems at a regional level**
- **Potential financing for transport/energy/climate change thematic areas through the Nordic Development Fund**

- **Natural Resource Management in Lao PDR: CEP/BCI leveraging \$36 million as part of “Sustainable Natural Resource Management and Productivity Enhancement Project.”**
- **BCI Upscaling: \$130 million (ADB funding \$65 million) in Lao PDR, Viet Nam and Cambodia**
- **Health Sector: GMS Rural Renewable Energy ; Flood Management and Mitigation Project**
- **SEA application: GIS/Spatial planning in Pacific Division ; SEA/CIA as part of integrated watershed management in Philippines**
