Under 1 Objectives, Scope and Guiding Principles

Guiding principles: (selected) (Bangkok)

- **Be country driven and voluntary**
- **Facilitate sustainable development, reduce poverty...**
- **Be results based**
- **Promote SMF**
- **Ensure that non permanence is addressed**
- **Ensure.....avoid leakage**

Guiding principles continued:

- **Ensure transparent forest governance**
- **UN declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples..... Members of Local Communities**
- **Promote actions that are consistent with the conservation of biological diversity,and do not provide incentives for conversion of natural forests.**
